STUDENT NURSE ACHIEVEMENT PROGRAM (SNAP)

Nursing students get paid while you learn, enhance your nursing skills, and improve your confidence before transitioning to the registered nurse role.

St. Elizabeth Healthcare is seeking outstanding student nurses for our Student Nurse Achievement Program (SNAP). SNAP emphasizes nursing training, patient care, understanding of nursing responsibilities, the structure, and functions of healthcare organizations.

THE SNAP PROGRAM:

- Invests in the student nurse through three levels, Student Nurse 1, 2, and 3.
- Is 12 to 18 months paid training, including clinical experiences to prepare for the registered nurse role after graduation.
- Offers \$21 per hour as Student Nurse 1.
- College credit hours for Student Nurse 2 (Nurse Extern Independent Study in summer) for participating schools

TO APPLY:

Applicants must be actively enrolled in an accredited school of nursing with a minimum 2.75 GPA.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Satisfactory completion of one semester clinical in nursing program
- Meet St. Elizabeth guidelines for employment (pre-employment drug screen, national background check, and submit immunization records).
- If entering as Student Nurse 1 - minimum 64 clinical work hours required, 12 hours paid shadowing experience.
- If entering as Student Nurse 2 (Summer) - Minimum 164 clinical work hours required
- If entering as Student Nurse 3 (Fall) - remainder of nursing program
